Dear Parent,

We are writing to address urgent safety concerns regarding student drop-off and pick-up. It has come to our attention that many parents and private drivers are not adhering to essential traffic regulations, creating significant risks for our students and the community.

To ensure the safety of all children, please immediately discontinue the following hazardous behaviors:

- Stopping vehicles in the middle of active traffic lanes.
- Opening doors while other vehicles are passing.
- Discharging students on the opposite side of the road, forcing them to run across traffic.
- Allowing students to exit vehicles from the side facing the road rather than the school.

The school maintains a zero-tolerance policy regarding these unsafe actions. Drivers must come to the school gate to drop off or pick up students, while facing the student side door to the school and not to the road. Please note that the school cannot be held responsible for incidents occurring outside the campus or after school hours due to non-compliance with these rules. Parents those who are relying on the Taxi Drivers are requested to alert and instruct them accordingly.

The safety of our children is a shared responsibility. Taking a proactive approach is key to preventing avoidable mishaps. We appreciate your immediate cooperation in maintaining a secure environment for every student & staff.
