SPELLING BEE COMPETITION

- A list of words has been uploaded onto the school website. Students should prepare from this list for the first round.
- Students have 1 minute to spell each word. They must begin spelling within 15 seconds of being called. Students must pronounce the word, spell it letter by letter, and repeat the word again. Eg: For the word "Bat," the student will say, "Bat. B-A-T, Bat."
- Correct spelling, pronunciation, speed, and confidence will be judged.
- A misspelled word results in elimination. The competition continues until one student remains or has correctly spelled maximum number of words.

Judging Criteria are (30 marks)

- **Correct Spelling, Pronunciation Speed and Confidence**
- Tiebreaker: In the event of a tie, students will continue taking turns until one misspells, and the other is declared the winner.
